City Opens Mass Testing Site at 616 Linden Avenue

Testing Site Will Soon be Able to Test up to 2,000 Individuals Per Day



SOUTH SAN FRANCISCO, Calif., Jan. 25, 2022

– The City of South San Francisco has partnered with the County of San Mateo in hosting a mass testing site at **616 Linden Avenue**. Residents are able to visit the testing site and receive a free, PCR COVID-19 test. Results are expected within 24-48 hours from test administration.

“I am thrilled that we have a mass testing site here in South San Francisco, in the heart of Downtown. Trying to find a PCR test lately has been incredibly difficult throughout the Bay Area, and I am ecstatic that our community will have access to these tests right in our own backyard” says South San Francisco Mayor Mark Nagales.

Effective Monday, January 24th, the testing site's hours are 8:00 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. and the site is able to provide up to 2,000 tests per day. The site will be open Monday through Saturday and is anticipated to be open at least through the end of February. Please pre-register for the testing site [here](#).

“I encourage all South San Francisco residents to get tested if you are experiencing any symptoms. Please do your part in slowing the spread so we can put an end to this pandemic” says South San Francisco Mayor Mark Nagales.

Testing sites are working on a first come, first served basis. Please note that the testing site may close up earlier if all tests have been exhausted earlier in the day. City staff will attempt all means necessary to get the word out if the site closes up early due to an exhaustion of supplies.
